Description of the Publicity and Member Individual also grants to the Association the authority to use his/her or its name, picture, likeness, logo, artwork, colographical details, and other identification, for the publicity, advertising and promotional purposes of the Association in conjunction with the rights referred to in the preceding sentence.

Title Sponsorships 1) The Association reserves the right to award Title Sponsorships for all USPA National and Circuit Events. 2) Host Clubs may, upon advance written request, be granted permission to acquire Title Sponsors (i.e. USPA "Sponsor Name" Gold Cup). 3) Host Clubs may be required to pay a portion of any Title Sponsorship Fee to the Association. 4) Host Clubs may not alter the name of any Association Event without prior written approval of the Association.

No Individual Member shall participate, either within or outside the United States, on a team alleging to represent the United States or the United States Pol Association, without the express written consent of the Association. 2.) Participating as a player in an event wearing a jersey inscribed with "USA", "USPA" or "United States" will create the inference of such an allege expresentation and any violation may be subject to the disciplinary procedures of Section 11 of these By-laws. 3.) When granting representation permission, the Association may provide identifying clothing, badges or marks to be worn by the team members.
