An alleged violation will be processed under the Equine Medications Rules (EMR) violation procedures, which include the possibility of a hearing, and penalties that include probation, suspension, and fines. The minimum penalties set forth below will serve as guidelines for the EMR Hearing Committee, which adjudicates most violations. An alleged EMR violation may be contested by the Responsible Party.
