## Regional and National President's Cup Tournament Conditions

Any USPA member club may apply to host a Regional President's Cup Event by having a minimum of four teams. One Regional President's Cup may be awarded within each circuit with the exception of the circuit hosting the National President's Cup (Florida Circuit). Four Regional President's Cup Events may be awarded within the Florida Circuit with play dates that do not overlap. Winning teams from the Regional President's Cup Events shall qualify to enter the National President's Cup. Teams that win a Regional President's Cup in the same calendar year but after the National President's Cup has been played shall qualify to participate in the National President's Cup the following year.

The National President's Cup will be played in conjunction with the U.S. Open Polo Championship at the National Polo Center.

- Teams qualified for the National President's Cup must maintain at least two of their original rostered players in order to participate in the National President's Cup.
- Member Clubs that host a Regional President's Cup will be charged \$5,000 to cover the cost of the National President's Cup played at the National Polo Center.
- The National President's Cup Host Tournament Committee has the option to extend a wildcard invitation in the event that there are not 4 qualified teams.
- The tournament format will be determined by the National President's Cup Host Tournament Committee depending on the number of teams entered.
- A USPA staff member shall be appointed by the Host Club to serve on the Regional President's Cup Host Tournament Committee.
